

Behaviour Management Policy

At Al-Falaah Educare, we encourage socially acceptable behaviour by praising the children and setting an example to them. We would like to treat the child as we would wish to be treated ourselves.

We aim to foster social behaviour through supervision and a variety of activities that are appropriate to the age and stage of the development of the children.

From time to time children may display unacceptable behaviour. This is a normal part of a child's development, and with guidance, their behaviour can be modified.

We try to encourage the development of the child's sense of right and wrong. Unacceptable behaviour such as biting, smacking, swearing, fighting etc. will be discussed with the child in the language the child understands at the place where it has occurred.

If a discussion along with distraction and diversion is not successful, the child will be removed from the situation for a short time. A cuddle from an adult often helps.

We do not smack, hit, kick, shout, talk rude and use a naughty chair or any other sanctions that would negatively affect the esteem of any child.

No child should be labelled.
